Our **venue** is the beautiful Margaret Aylward Centre for Faith and Dialogue, Holy Faith Sisters in Glasnevin, Dublin. <https://www.margaretaylwardcentre.ie/>

Glasnevin is around 3 miles from Dublin city centre. There is a bus stop at Met Eireann on Glasnevin Hill. This is near the entrance to the venue. There is a regular bus service from Dublin city centre. It is a 20-minute walk from Drumcondra train station to the Centre. Drumcondra is a stop on the route from/to Maynooth, Sligo and other trains running west. On exiting the station, turn left and follow Drumcondra Road, turn left onto Botanic Avenue and continue to the T junction at Our Lady of Dolours Church, turn right and walk up Glasnevin Hill past Met Eireann to arrive at the gates of the centre.

Another option is to get a taxi from the city centre which takes 10 to 15 minutes.

Parking:

Free parking is available adjacent to the centre. Drive in the main gates, turn right and follow the road.

Refreshments/Lunch

Teas/coffees will be available on arrival and again at lunch time at no extra cost.

A lunch area is available for those should you wish to bring your own lunch. There is a small convenience shop at the bottom of the hill with a selection of sandwiches. Alternatively, McMahons café is a 5 minute walk at the bottom of the hill opposite the church. They do a range of soups, sandwiches, coffees etc. There is also a café in the Botanic Gardens for anyone who would like a warm meal (please note that this can be busy at lunchtimes).

Accommodation

There are several hotels and B&B's in the general area. Book well in advance if you are planning to stay overnight.
